I have a few tires at home. How can I recycle them?

There are several ways to dispose of used tires properly:

- ⇒ -Bring used tires to a local tire collection or event for disposal.
- ⇒ Leave used tires with a reputable tire dealer.
- ⇒ Contact your county or local recycling center and ask if they accept used tires.
- ⇒ PLEASE, DO NOT ILLEGALLY DUMP TIRES.

What are the benefits of incinerating scrap tires for energy recovery?

-Tires produce the same amount of energy as oil and 25% more energy than coal.

-The oil equivalency of a passenger tire is 7 gallons and the heat content of shredded tires is 10 to 16% higher than that of coal.

-Tires have a high heating value; each pound of scrap tire rubber is equivalent to 15,000 BTU's of energy.



Some interesting facts

- In the United States more than half the rubber used each year is made into tires.
- In 2006 over 300 million new tires were shipped out to be used by cars and trucks.
- About 80 percent (240 million) were used by passenger cars.
- About 20 percent (60 million) were used by trucks.

Ideas to recycle tires

-With one tire you can make a tire swing in your backyard.

-Tire gardens can be a simple cost effective way to plant a garden in urban areas and an environmentally friendly way to turn used tires into something productive again.

-Recycle tires by making a bike rack
